CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATE JIM KELLER TO ATTEND MARCH 19 PEACE
RALLY IN PASADENA

Libertarian Congressional Candidate Jim Keller will be among the people attending a peace rally and march on Sunday, March 19, in Pasadena.

"It's very exciting to see all these different peace groups coming together," Keller said. "We desperately need to start working together if we're going to end this war."

The rally and march are being organized by the Foothills Peace Coalition, a newly formed non-partisan umbrella organization which is seeking to coordinate the efforts of the numerous anti-war groups that have sprung up throughout the region. The coalition is comprised of representatives of different organizations which all share the common goal of ending the Iraq war. Keller has volunteered to represent various Libertarian interests with the coalition.

"It's very exciting that this non-partisan group has formed," Keller said. "Peace cannot be a partisan issue. People of all political parties and beliefs need to come together if we're going to end the war."

The rally begins at 2:00 PM on Sunday, March 19. Attendees should assemble in the park at the corner of Del Mar and Fair Oaks in Pasadena. The march will begin at approximately 3:00 PM. Anyone interested in the Iraq issue is encouraged to participate.

Since the march and rally are non-partisan events, Keller emphasizes that he is there as a participant, not to campaign. "Stopping the war is more important than winning the election, though winning the election would certainly help stop the war," he teased.

Keller expects other parties' candidates for the 29th District Congressional Race to also attend. "I believe we can work together," he said. "If we can't, we shouldn't be in politics."

Jim Keller is the Libertarian candidate for U.S. Congress representing California's 29th District (Pasadena - South Pasadena - Altadena - Alhambra - Burbank - Glendale - San
